Join us for a fascinating discussion with **Ambassador Robert Gallucci**, who will be offering his thoughts on the challenges that America faces by the year 2040.

**ROBERT L. GALLUCCI** is Distinguished Professor in the Practice of Diplomacy at Georgetown University’s Walsh School of Foreign Service. He was President of the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation from 2009 until 2014, following his thirteen year tenure as Dean of the School of Foreign Service at Georgetown University. Previously, as Ambassador-at-Large and Special Envoy for the U.S. State Department, he dealt with threats posed by the proliferation of ballistic missiles and weapons of mass destruction. He was chief U.S. negotiator during the North Korean nuclear crisis of 1994. He was also Assistant Secretary of State for Political Military Affairs, and served as the Deputy Executive Chairman of the UN Special Commission overseeing the disarmament of Iraq after the first Gulf War. He earned his Bachelor’s degree at the SUNY, Stony Brook and his Master’s and Doctoral degrees at Brandeis University.

**Nearest Metro:** Foggy Bottom.

**Walking Directions from Metro:**

- **Exit the Foggy Bottom Station (Blue/Orange/Silver Lines) and Cross 23rd St.**
- **Walk three blocks east on “ I ” (‘eye’) St.**
- **Turn right on 20th St., and walk approximately 4 blocks south to the ‘E’ Street.**
- **Turn right and the entrance to The Elliott School is on the right.**

**Parking:** Parking on campus is a challenge due to construction, so we encourage public transport. On-campus street parking is available, but is limited, and time limits are *strictly enforced*. There is DC parking in the immediate vicinity. Visitors and guests of the GWU Campus may be accommodated at:

- **Academic Center Garage** (on I (‘eye’) St. between 21st and 22nd Sts.). Open 24/7.
- **Marvin Center** (on H St. between 21st and 22nd Sts.). Open from 7 a.m. til midnight daily.
- **G Street Garage** (entrances on 20th and 21st Sts. in alley way between F and G Sts.). Open 24/7. *[This is a self-service garage, and only accepts MasterCard and Visa for payment]*
