“ISIS, A Collective Intelligence System, For an Egyptian Renaissance“



The Leadership of the National Capital Chapter of the World Future Society is pleased to announce the second of our 2013/14 Speaker's Series...Please join us on Thursday, October 17th at the historic Hotel Lombardy* in Downtown D.C. as we welcome Jerome Glenn, Director of The Millennium Project. Jerry will present on the new Collective Intelligence system, ISIS, currently in development for, and with, Egypt.

Egypt needs a system that makes it easy to see the nation's situation as-a-whole, its future options, and the full range of the citizens' views, government programs, and feedback on priorities. ISIS (Integrated Synergetic Information System) is integrating government documents, programs, and other information about Egypt along with Egypt's major challenges. The Millennium Project is creating I.S.I.S. with the Egyptian Academy of Scientific Research and Technology. The mission of I.S.I.S. is to support the renaissance of Egypt, and is based on the Global Futures Intelligence System at www.themp.org. The Millennium Project's primary website is www.millenniumproject.org.

Jerome C. Glenn has 40 years of futures research experience with several think tanks and is the co-founder and CEO of The Millennium Project, a global participatory think tank that produces the annual "State of the Future" reports, the "Futures Research Methodology" series, Global Futures Intelligence System, and related software, and special studies.
